
Purpose

Program Structure


Indian Trails is a Microsoft Office Certified Testing Center. Students who are enrolled in the Business & Computer Science classes have the opportunity to certify in Microsoft Office Word, PowerPoint, Excel, Access, OneNote and Outlook.

Digital Information Technology is a

year long, high school credit class that is designed to provide an introduction to information technology concepts and careers as well as the impact information technology has on the world, people, and industry. The content includes; information technology career research, operating systems and software applications, electronic communications including email and Internet services and basic webpage design. This is a hybrid course which means students will receive both online and classroom content and assignments. This course meets the requirements for the practical arts credit and online credit which are both needed for graduation.

Computer Applications in Business is

a semester course that provides keyboarding and computer skills needed by students in order to be successful in high school, college and at work. The content of this course includes keyboarding, word processing, spreadsheets and database skills and Microsoft Office software functions.
